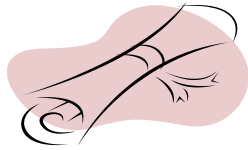
SENIOR CHECK-OUT

GRADUATION TRY-OUTS

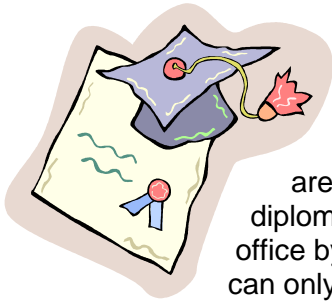
Graduation Speeches:
