Bullard High School will continue to partner with the Center for Black Educator Development to provide student impact circles to provide a safe place for students to share their thoughts, ask questions, address community harms, and make a difference. If you are ready to use your voice, we are ready to act alongside you to create real change at Bullard. ALL STUDENTS AND ALL GRADES are welcomed. The first 250 students to return permission slips by March 22nd will be admitted. Permission slips can be picked up in the Counseling Office or on our website.

As many know, Bullard implemented its new school wide smartphone policy back in November. Parents, please remind your student that pouches must be brought to school every day and phones are to be placed in their pouches when entering their first period of the day. Students who fail to comply to the new policy by not placing their phones in the pouch or placing burner phones or other items in their pouch, will face consequences and their phones will be confiscated and will require parents to pick up the phones after school or the next day. Bluetooth headphones, ear buds, or air pods are also not allowed to be used during class time unless being used for educational or testing purposes.

We want to remind our students that all students must follow the school dress code when at school. Parents, please help us in keeping our students accountable by conducting a quick check of your student's attire when leaving home for the school day. A few important tips are that no hats, unless they are Bullard hats, no single item of clothing can be more than 50% red or royal blue, and pajama pants are not allowed to be worn to school.

This is a reminder that no outside food from any food delivery service or parents will be accepted during the school day due to safety reasons. All food will be turned away and Bullard High School will not be responsible for any refunds.
